Country Reports provide key information on political conditions, security issues, travel logistics, cultural factors, contact details and health advisories.

Case Studies help you understand how we assist travelers from minor injuries to life-threatening situations.

Travel Articles enable you to read the latest travel tips and news on destinations worldwide.

Assistance ID Card is also available online in the event the physical card is mislaid or left at home.

Travel Health educates travelers on health-related concerns, precautions and requirements for destinations and ability to create personal travel health profiles.

Medical Translations Tool translates medical terms and phrases into multiple languages.

Drug Brand Equivalency Tool generates drug brand names and their equivalent names for multiple countries.

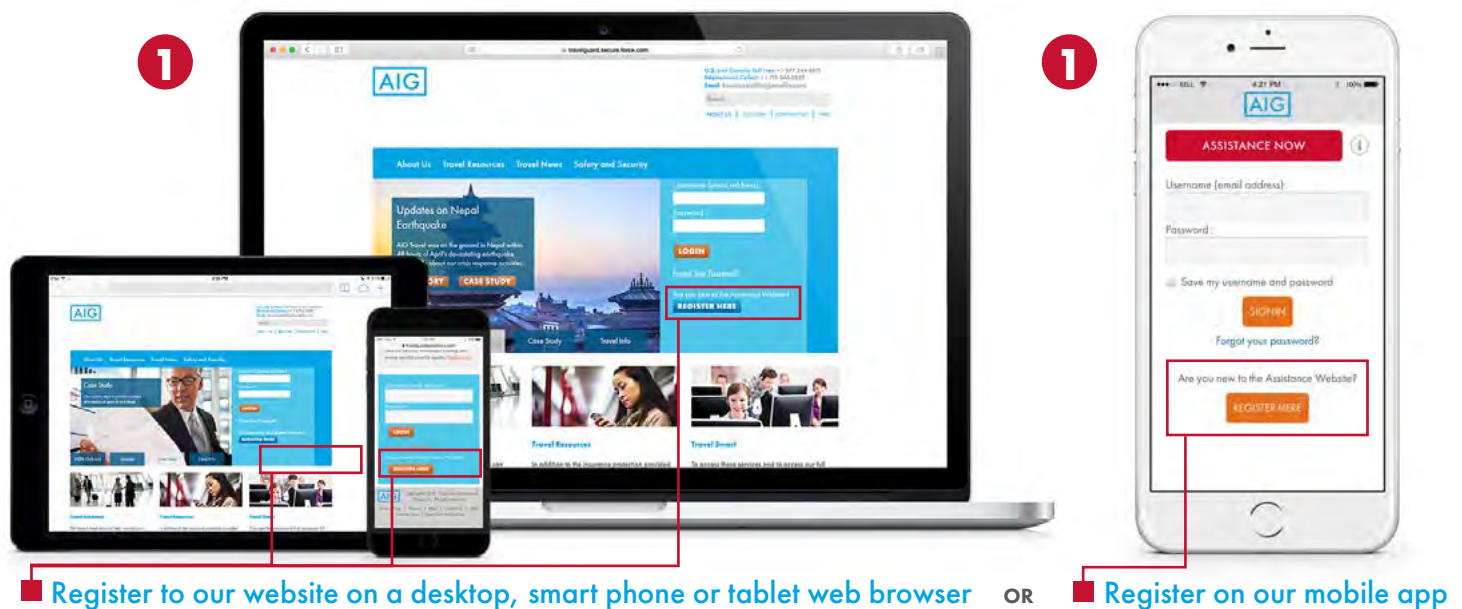

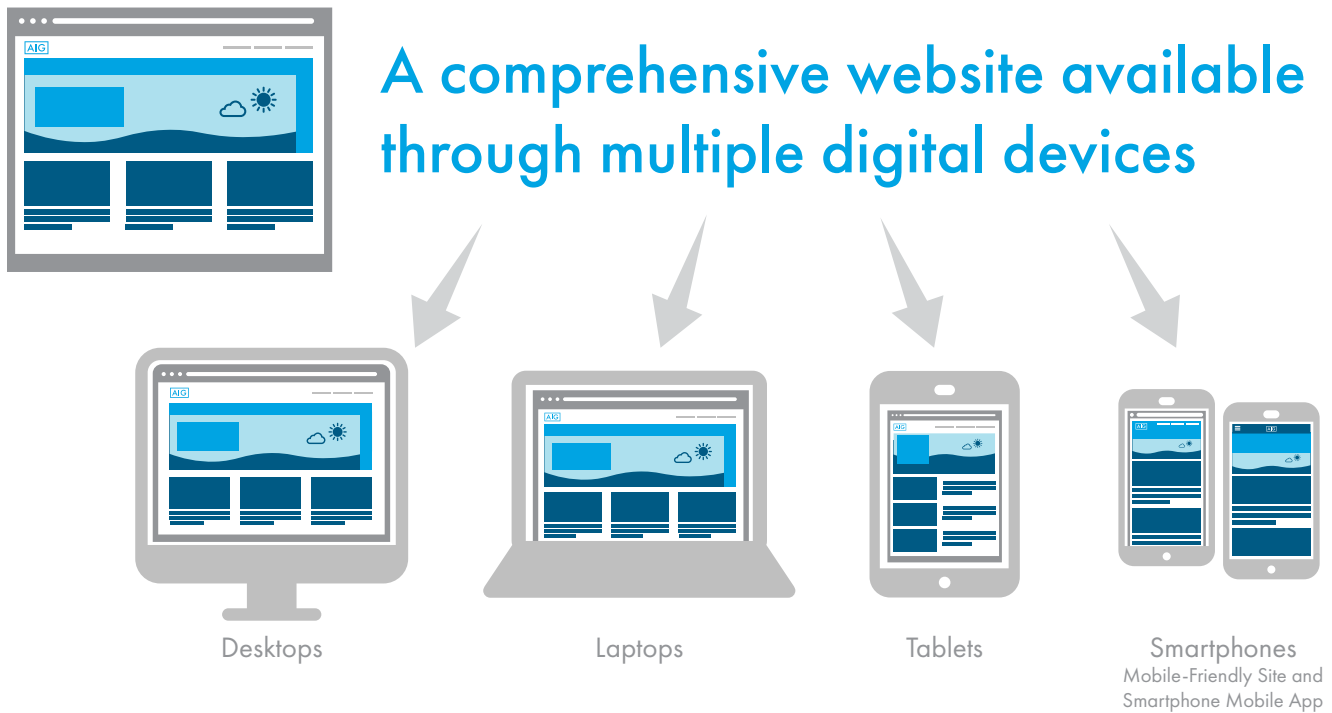

Digital environments for the travel assistance website



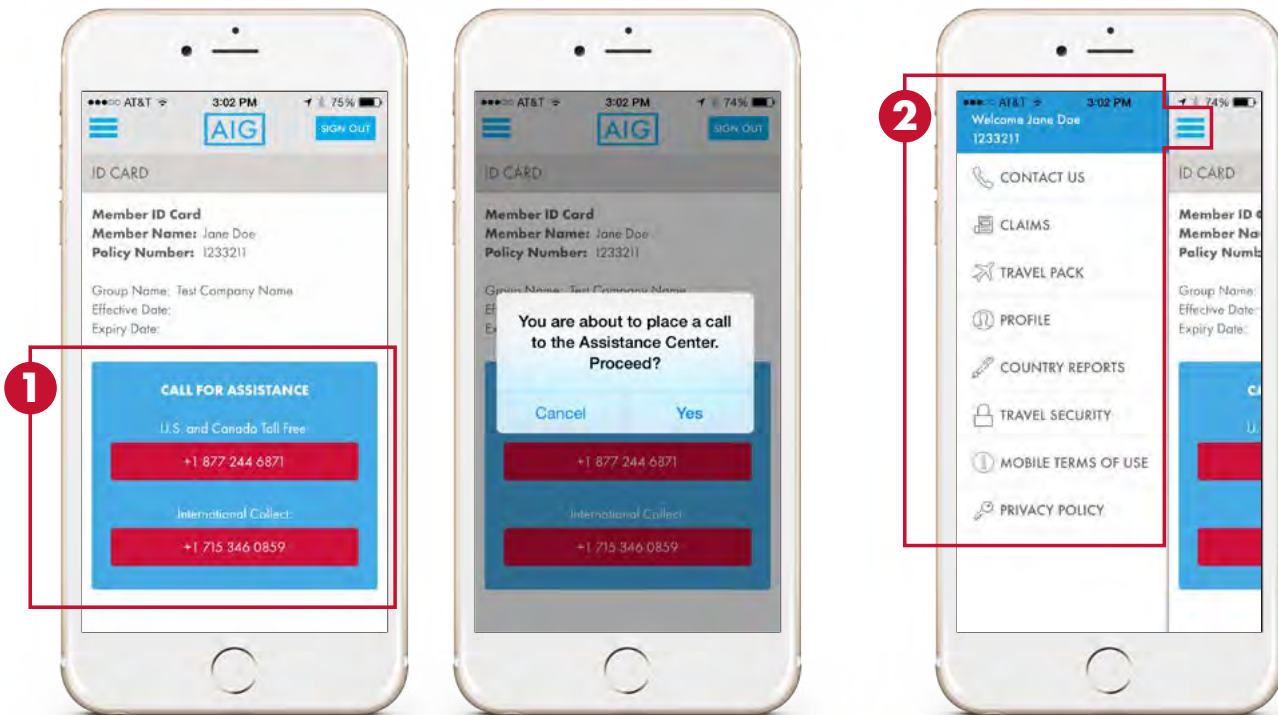

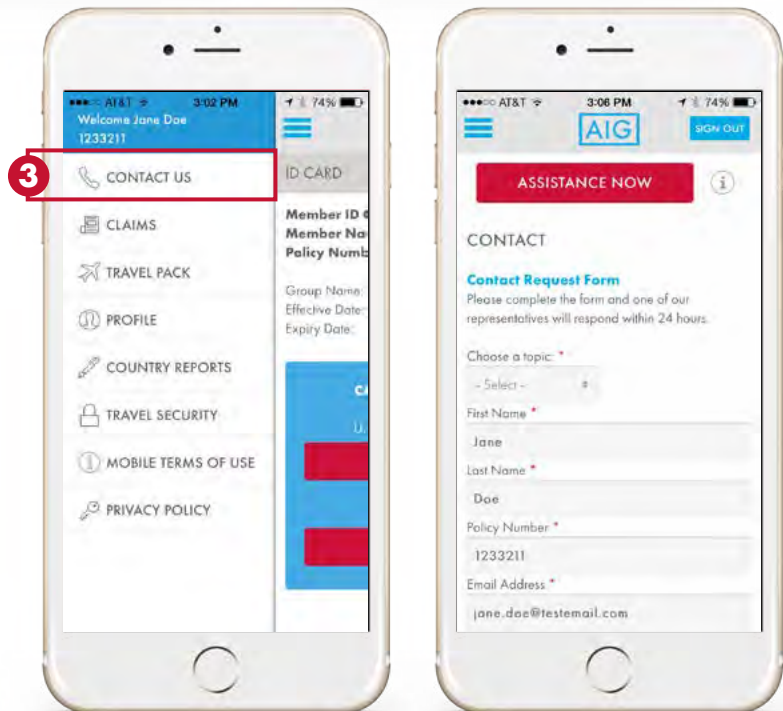

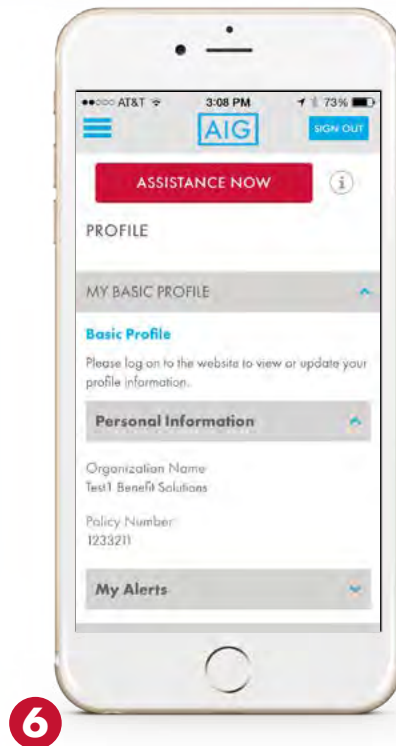

Overview

- AIG Global Security rates Argentina as a MODERATE threat destination due to the risks posed by crime and kidnapping.

Argentina, along with Chile, Paraguay, Uruguay and southwestern Brazil, make up the Southern Cone geographical region of South America. Argentina is geographically the eighth-largest country in the world and hosts a population of 41 million people. Its capital city, Buenos Aires, is located along its southeastern coast; other prominent urban centers include Cordoba, Mendoza and Rosario. Although it is part of the G-20 and considered a regional middle power, its current political, economic and social situation has halted growth and credibility.

The country is rated as a medium risk destination due to significant but medium rates of crime and kidnapping, while regular instances of civil unrest and a small but significant terrorist threat are further security concerns. Both petty and violent crimes are particularly prevalent in Argentina's major cities, including Buenos Aires, Cordoba, Mendoza and Rosario, and while levels are lower in other parts of the country, the threat of crime is present throughout Argentina. There are also high levels of kidnap for ransom and express kidnapping in Argentina, with the risk considered higher in provincial capitals.

As of 2015, the country is experiencing hardships comparable to the ones experienced during the 2001 collapse of the country's economy which included shortages and the decrease of currency value. President Cristina Fernandez de Kirchner is head of state and a member of the Justicialist Party. Despite having experienced relatively high public support in the past, ongoing allegations of corruption in her administration, which have resulted in criminal investigations, has sparked instances of civil unrest as well as declining public approval ratings. Other incidents of civil unrest related to the economy, as well as to politics or labor disputes, are regularly reported countrywide and often result in localized travel disruptions. While demonstrations are generally peaceful, anarchist elements have previously infiltrated such actions to incite unrest and violence.

In addition, there is a low threat from terrorism, stemming largely from domestic political extremist organizations and transnational terrorist groups. Evidence suggests that transnational organizations maintain a clandestine presence near Argentina's tri-border area (TBA) near Brazil and Paraguay, while domestic groups have staged small-scale attacks in Buenos Aires in the past; the presence of such groups, including the Lebanese Hezbollah, the Hong Kong Mafia, as well as various indigenous criminal organizations, raises the level of insecurity in this region.

Infrastructure in Argentina is generally sound around large cities; however, conditions are variable in more rural parts of the country. For a period of over ten years, Argentina recovered from this deep recession and remained politically stable as well as economically solvent; however recent events such debt default as well as corruption cases have lowered the country's growth. Manufacturing is Argentina's largest economic sector, constituting nearly 20 percent of the country's gross domestic product (GDP). Argentina's economy is the third-largest in Latin America behind Brazil and Mexico, respectively, and the country has the second highest GDP per capita in South America.

Travel advisories and areas of concern

Due to persistent insecurity stemming from the presence of transnational criminal and terrorist organizations in the tri-border area (TBA) between Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay, travelers are advised against all non-essential travel to rural and remote areas of Argentina's Misiones province. Furthermore, individuals are advised against all non-essential travel to the country's low-income neighborhoods (known locally as villas miserias), which are generally situated on the outskirts of most major cities, due to high levels of gang- and drug-related crime.
